Beginnings: The REACH Foundation was established in 2003 as a result of the sale of Health Midwest, a nonprofit hospital and health care organization, to Hospital Corporation of America. Two new charitable foundations were established with proceeds from the sale, the REACH Healthcare Foundation, incorporated in Kansas, and the Health Care Foundation of Greater Kansas City, incorporated in Missouri.

Our Focus: Our primary focus is on expanding health care access and health care quality for poor and medically underserved people.

Service Area: Allen, Johnson and Wyandotte counties in Kansas, and Cass, Jackson and Lafayette counties in Missouri, and the community within Kansas City, Missouri.

Assets: \$125.5 million as of December 31, 2010.

Grant Making: REACH awards approximately \$5 million annually to nonprofit organizations whose work aligns with our key interest areas – access to health care and quality oral health, mental health and safety net health services.

Total Awards: \$28 million since 2005

Leadership: The REACH Foundation is governed by a 17-member Board of Directors elected by its members. Brenda Sharpe is President and CEO of the REACH Foundation.
