



Population Shift: Percent Change by Age, 2000-2011


Population by Race, 2011






Population Density






Unemployment Rate






Poverty by Census Tract











KEY COUNTY CONCERNS:

Rising obesity rates and a projected increase in the older population will likely strain the health care system.

The county has a very high poverty rate, with over half of the residents at or below 200 percent of the Federal Poverty Level.

The percent of Wyandotte County residents who have not seen a doctor in the past year due to cost is almost double the state average.

County residents have fewer health care providers per capita than are available in more affluent counties.
